
Tiny Homes ~ BIG Dreams



VISION: To support community wellness, healing and reconciliation by completing the reclamation of the Chooutla Residential School site and area.




























Reconciliation & Relationships:

The Montana Mountain Mines Roadmap to Remediation and Reconciliation
Project, is a joint initiative between C/TFN and CIRNAC, delivered by C/TMC.

CTMC manages all mining related initiatives, including abandoned mines, specifically within the Traditional and Self-Governing Territory of the Government of the C/TFN.

C/TFN is guiding CIRNAC on the project on a Government-to-Government level.

CIRNAC is liable and responsible for the site, but not in charge of the site.

CTMC implements and manages the projects' delivery through the CTMC Stewardship Program. The program is a diverse and inclusive capacity development program, aimed at connecting citizens with traditional knowledge for their day to day use in employment and career development to the benefit of the entire community and their economy.
